15 In our foundry, it was a right family business as I said, and most of the men who worked in the foundry worked there from when they left the school until they retired. A lot of factories, people start and they'll change jobs, and change jobs and change jobs but these chaps didn't. They mostly worked from when they left the school probably at 15 till they retired at 65. In fact some worked on till they were 70. We had great guys in the factory and we worked as a team which is very important. Say if something goes wrong in the foundry, say there was fault in the furnace and it breaks down—or what could happen is you could get a leak in the furnace where there was metal spillage and everybody would start running and help and get it cleared up. So it was very important that you worked as a team.
